

Minutes of the review meeting with District Coordinators and Bank Linkage Specialist held on 27.08.2019 at APMEPMA Head Office, Guntur.

All the DMCs (BL) and Bank Linkage Specialist attended the meeting except DMC of Kurnool. Anantapuram District has deputed CO to attend the meeting.

At the outset the Mission Director, MEPMA has reviewed District and ULB wise performance of Bank linkage, SEP, Overdue position and Street Vendors with the District Coordinators and Bank Linkage Specialists and the Action Points are as follows:

BANK LINKAGE:

It is resolved to take up the following Action Points with immediate effort:

- **SHG - Bank Linkage:** To achieve the double the targets set in the online, as informed earlier.
Poor performing Districts: GVMC, Guntur, Nellore, Prakasam, West Godavari, Chittor and Krishna.
- SEP (I):** Zero performing districts are GVMC and Visakhapatnam.
Poor performing Districts: West Godavari, Prakasam, Kurnool, Guntur, Krishna, VMC, Nellore and Vizianagaram.
- SEP (G):** Zero performing Districts: West Godavari, VMC, Visakhapatnam, Nellore, Prakasam, GVMC, and East Godavari.
Poor performing Districts: Krishna, Srikakulam, Kurnool, Anantapuram, Vizianagaram, Guntur.
Ensure 30% of the SEP beneficiaries are Street Vendors and ESTP trainees.
Ensure all ULBs and Districts should reach 200% results before 30.09.2019
- It is reiterated that the data available in the online only will be reviewed and offline data is not considered.
- **To update the SEP (I&G) data of previous years in MEPMA portal for claiming Interest Subvention, before 25.09.2019.**
- To conduct TLBC meetings every Month in all ULBs and submit the minutes of the meeting with geo tagging to PD office and attend JMLBC / DCC/DLRC meeting and represent our grievances.

- To conduct CBRM regularly and reduce the NPA from 3.59 % to less than 2% and Stree Nidhi NPA from 10% to less than 5% by 30-09-2019.
- Conduct minimum ten Financial Literacy camps at problematic areas and ensure the participation of local Bank Managers or Field Officers invariably.

AMD reviewed the position of YSR Aasara updation and advised the forum to coordinate with IBs and complete the task successfully.

- It is advised to cross check the data shared by the Banks with MEPMA records and entry regularly and ensure the correctness with the Bank data and confirm the sharing the data is exactly tallying.
- It is resolved to (1) verify the multiple accounts data and (2) Non-sharing data by Banks and facilitate IB persons to update the data before 30.08.2019.
- It is resolved to review the performance of all DMC-BL and TE-BL on weekly basis, and non-performance will be viewed seriously.
