In the reference 1st cited, the Joint Secretary, UD & LSG has stated that every year Constitution Day is celebrated on 26th November to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India and to honor and pay tributes to the invaluable contributions of Babasaheb Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar and other founding members whereby reading of the 'Preamble' to the Constitution is observed. This year marks the 70th Anniversary of adoption of the Constitution of India across all the States/UTs starting from 26th November, 2019 to 26th November, 2020.

In the reference 2nd cited, the Govt., while enclosing a copy of reference 1st cited, has requested to follow the instructions issued by Govt. of India regarding 'Constitution Day Celebrations' from 26th November, 2019 to 26th November, 2020 and take necessary action in the matter.

Therefore, in view of the instructions issued by GOI and the State Government, to create awareness and to lay emphasis on the Fundamental Duties, all the Project Directors, PD GVMC and PO VMC are instructed to organize the following activities in all the ULBs in coordination with the Municipal Commissioners and other line Departments from 26th January, 2020 to 26th November, 2020.

Activities to be Conducted:-

1. To include Constitution Day and reading of the 'Preamble' to the Constitution in the Agenda of all SHGs, SLFs and TLFs monthly meetings.
2. Solidarity campaigning focused on Citizen's duties should be organized by conducting Seminars/Conferences/talks at District/ULB level in coordination with line Departments.
3. 1K / 2K / 3K Walks/runs to be organized to educate on the adoption of Constitution of India and Citizen's Fundamental Duties.
4. Rallies with banners and suitable play-cards to educate SHG Women as well as public on Constitution of India.
5. To do publicity on website through Flyers, standees etc. throughout the campaign.
6. Meetings on citizens' duties by Municipalities & Corporations during the campaign.

All the Project Directors are requested to conduct the above said activities along with mass involvement of people and members of Self Help Groups. Other innovative measures like essay competitions, recitation competitions, poster making etc., may also be organized and submit report along with good quality photographs of this program to Head office for documentation. Moreover, a report card reading event shall also be convened wherein the initiatives taken under Mission shall be highlighted.

The expenditure shall be met from the IEC - 1- 35- 415 component not exceeding Rs.1000/- (One Thousand rupees) per Municipality/Corporation for cloth banners, IEC material and miscellaneous expenditure.


